OUR HISTORY . . .

The group began in 2009 when two ladies from Jamestown were diagnosed with cancer: Donna Boggs and Julie Baker. These ladies soon realized that there was no assistance for them in the community and recognizing the need throughout the Greeneview Local School District. These ladies contacted some friends and neighbors, scheduled a meeting, and thus began the Jamestown Families Cancer Care. They aimed to assist in whatever way would be helpful to cancer patients that were going through treatment. In September of that year, they set up a small tent at the Jamestown Bean Festival to get the word out about what they were doing, their mission, and their goals. Since then, a tent has been set up at the Fall Festival, (except in 2020 during the COVID pandemic), only the tent has doubled in size.

In September 2010, the group held their first Cancer Walk. The walk is a yearly event, with a closing ceremony in honor of those we have lost to cancer.

In May 2015, the group established a scholarship fund to be given to a Greeneview High School Senior planning to pursue studies in the medical field. An additional scholarship was added in May 2018, for an additional Senior recipient.

The group feels very blessed with the donations we receive, the support from kind businesses, and the support of the Greeneview Local School District and the community at large.
